



The Year in Review

This has been a good year for Nature Camp and the Nature Camp Foundation in spite of the national economic climate. Attendance at the four youth sessions totaled 352, the fourth highest attendance in Camp's 69-year history. Adult session in August added another thirty campers. The over half million dollar renovation and construction completed in 2008 has proven sound. And while some "Campaign for Nature Camp" pledges have not yet been fulfilled, in September the Foundation was able to pay off the \$40,000 debt it incurred in 2008 to complete the construction on time.

Camp thrives because of the commitment to excellence embraced by everyone across the board, from the Executive Director, Flip Coulling and the summer staff, to the Board of Nature Camp, Inc., and ultimately to the Foundation's own ardent members—you. The purpose of the Foundation, of course, is to focus the efforts of friends and alumni to help with financial, material, and service support. The financial picture has been positive. We have done away with the original dues-based membership structure and replaced it with one that is donations-based. During 2009, almost \$75,000 in gifts was received, about half from capital campaign pledges and half from annual giving.

Strong commitment to Nature Camp through service was evidenced during the spring and fall service weekends. A total of 128 individuals participated, and since a number came to both weekends, we had in effect 158 volunteers helping maintain the facilities. Prime among the projects has been replacing shingles on buildings with older roofs, and the main Lillian Schilling roof, after several successive service weekends across two years, will finally be completed this coming spring. These and other important maintenance efforts were most ably planned and coordinated by Jim Brooks, the Chair of Facilities for the Foundation.

As Nature Camp enters a new, and we hope more financially sustainable, phase, the Foundation has shifted its priorities from capital improvements to creating a stronger financial base for tuition assistance and scholarships. Such assistance has gained increasing importance in today's troubled economy, and the need can be expected to continue. Happily, Camp tuition has been able to remain unchanged for the past four years, at \$700 per youth per two-week session, and will continue to remain so during the coming summer. To the extent we can keep that tuition affordable for many youngsters and families, Nature Camp will be able to attract and provide opportunities for more young people than could otherwise attend.

For this reason, the Foundation is embarking on a long term effort to generate and set aside a Scholarship Account, interest on the principal of which would support tuition assistance. To date, scholarships have been awarded in the same year donations were received, and the hope is to augment these annual individual scholarships with the proceeds from this more permanent and sustainable fund. You can help us build this fund by a donation payable to the Nature Camp Foundation, marked in the memo corner for "Scholarship Account," and send it to the NCF Treasurer, P.O. Box 3091, Lynchburg, VA 24503.

The generosity of the friends and supporters of Nature Camp and the Foundation has been magnificent, and the testimony of their—your—support this past year is detailed in the following pages of this report. You have shown that the switch to a donations-based membership has been positive. Yet it is often easy to become complacent, to believe that the crisis Camp faced a few short years ago is over, and we can relax. I believe that would be the wrong message and the wrong conclusion.

Nature Camp exists only because of the continuing commitment of its unique and long-standing community. In the past few years, we have seen how, when support wavers, the future of Camp can be threatened. We must not let that happen again. Your support remains crucial to the treasure that is Nature Camp. It is now nearing the end of its seventh decade of opening the eyes of our young people to the wonders, the challenges, and the responsibilities of being stewards of our natural resources. Thank you for what you have done and the legacy you have helped create. You were there when Camp needed you most. Our future campers are counting on your being there for them in the years ahead.
