The Year in Review

2018 marked yet another year of supporting Nature Camp in their mission of providing environmental hands-on learning to a cadre of enthusiastic youth and adults. I have truly enjoyed my first year as president of an organization I have been a part of most of my life. I must admit, this new role has been much more challenging and broader than my former role as NCF Communication Chair, but so rewarding. We have a "young" board with many new faces dedicating themselves to learning and growing in their new roles. I am deeply grateful for the talent and dedication these folks bring to our board.

The Nature Camp Foundation experienced another strong year in 2018. Our continued ability to support the mission of Camp and provide much needed financial support in many areas is due to the unwavering support of the Nature Camp Community – campers, staff, alumni, volunteers, garden clubs, foundations and other community organizations. Indeed, camp continues to thrive due to the active contributions of you and other members of our community.

The Nature Camp Foundation provided over \$48,000 in direct financial support to Nature Camp in 2018. These funds supported:

- Camper financial aid and scholarships (\$25,139)
- Equipment and capital improvements around Camp (\$4,097)
- Service Weekend materials (\$3,000)
- Funding for Phase I of the Education Building Renovations (\$2,903)
- Investment of \$13,702 in our scholarship funds as we continue to build a strong investment base to help assure that any child who would like to attend Nature Camp will not be limited by finances.

The Nature Camp Foundation hosted two Service Weekends in 2018 (actually more like one and a half since we had to postpone the fall weekend due to jumpy hurricane induced weather). During these gatherings we fed, housed, and coordinated the efforts of up to 75 volunteers in the spring and about 25 in the fall. Service Weekends are held annually on the third weekends in May and September. Principal projects during 2018 included the continuation of replacing floor joists under Camp buildings, improving lighting and ventilation in the kitchen, treating buildings with carbolineum, and a variety of upkeep tasks around campus. For the first time in many years we were not reroofing the buildings! This and other work completed by volunteers during Service Weekends saves Camp thousands of dollars each year, and we have a great time full of laughter and music as well.

Camper enrollment continues to remain steady for both youth and adult sessions. 326 campers from grades 5 to12 enrolled in the youth sessions and 48 campers and 34 staff/instructors attended Adult Session this past summer. In 2018 the NCF provided \$15,000 in scholarship aid in addition to funding from our scholarship accounts (the NCF, the Gus Deeds, and the Stuart Craig Scholarship Funds), financial support equivalent to

almost 22 full scholarships. These contributions, combined with those of Garden Clubs and other generous scholarship providers, ensure that youth from all backgrounds have access to a high quality, meaningful Nature Camp experience. Of the youth who came to Nature Camp in 2018, 40.6% received some form of financial assistance.

In 2018, the Nature Camp Foundation continued to broaden use of our constituent management system, eTapestry, to facilitate staying in touch with members of the Nature Camp community. We've expanded our digital capabilities through email, social media, our website, and online voting for board positions.

The NCF is in strong financial shape, ending 2018 with net assets of \$833,806. Our investments followed the market, experiencing gains in 2018. At year end, the Legacy Account, a fund supporting the long-term operation and mission of Nature Camp, held \$501,458. Our scholarship accounts, which provide a long-term source of financial assistance to campers, were valued as follows: The Gus Deeds Scholarship Account at \$40,710, the Stuart Craig Scholarship Account at \$17,862 and the NCF Scholarship Account at \$135,430. And we ended the year with \$86,757 in operating funds.

Nature Camp continues to be blessed with dedicated and strong volunteer leadership on both the NCF and NCI Boards. During 2018 those NCF board members that stepped in to fill vacancies have been invaluable to completing numerous tasks. Since so many stepped in to fill positions vacated before term completion, we offered a slate of officers in our recent election. Electing for a first full term Jason Farr - At-large, and re-electing for a second term Amy Clark – Treasurer and Louise Bowling – Secretary. Amy Gonzalez was appointed to her first full term as our Development Chair and has been very busy getting things in place to kick off a Capital Campaign in 2019. As always, we must recognize the continuing and invaluable contributions the members of the Nature Camp, Inc. board and of Philip Coulling, the Executive Director of Nature Camp. It is their leadership that sustains the wonderful tradition of the Nature Camp experience.
