The Year in Review

In 2022 the Nature Camp Foundation finally resumed normal activities for the year, even including a joint NCF and Nature Camp, Inc. strategic planning retreat, and the twice postponed NCF Reunion. Nature Camp, Inc. was able to return to the normal set of four 2-week youth sessions and Adult Session was held in June. These steps back to normality have gladdened our hearts and we hope to see folks able to gather more and more along the shores of Big Mary's Creek in the coming year(s).

The Nature Camp Foundation experienced another year of strong donor support. Our Nature Camp family continually amazes us with your generosity, and we are deeply grateful for all the support you all have shown throughout the years including the very odd "covid" years. Our continued ability to support the mission of Nature Camp and provide much needed financial support in many areas is due to the unwavering support of all of you – campers, parents of campers, staff, alumni, volunteers, garden clubs, foundations, and other community organizations. Nature Camp expanded their use of the completed Education Building this past summer and they are looking forward to a beautiful new table addition (made by the very talented Jerry Wine from local wood donated by former Executive Director Brent Heath and wood donated by Jerry Wine) in the front area. The Education Building was finally formally celebrated with a ribbon cutting ceremony/party during the Reunion.

In 2022 your support exceeded the annual fund goal set by the NCF. These funds allowed us to support Nature Camp in these key areas for 2022:

- Capital improvements around Camp including a new porch on the boys' bunkhouse, repairs to the girls' bunkhouse porch, handrails for the caretaker's residence stairs, new clothesline supports.
- New concrete pavers were installed by the water fountain.
- New washing machine for the Outhouse.
- Significant camper scholarship funds.

The Nature Camp Foundation is continually working to streamline and cleanup our constituent management system, eTapestry, which continues to provide a much-needed functionality to facilitate staying in touch with members of the Nature Camp community, and to allow us to track and acknowledge donations and in-kind service. Registration forms that allow us to make sure we have needed information such as numbers for meals (plus special dietary needs), sleeping arrangements, t-shirt sizes etc. were implemented for all NCF events and are making our preparations for welcoming all of you to Camp much easier. Thank you for working with us on getting these into normal use!

The NCF underwent an external financial review of our accounts and procedures in 2022 and we are happy to report we are in strong financial shape. The NCF ended 2022 with net assets of \$1,222,587. Our investments followed the market, experiencing losses in 2022. At year end the Legacy Account, a fund supporting the long-term operation and mission of

Nature Camp, held \$636,962. Our scholarship accounts, which provide a long-term source of financial assistance to campers, were valued as follows: The Gus Deeds Scholarship Account at \$59,632, the Stuart Craig Scholarship Account at \$31,054, the Emma Nicholas Scholarship Account at \$10,019, and the NCF Scholarship Account at \$198,648. And we ended the year with \$166,799 in operating funds. The NCF Operational Reserve Fund (holding funds in reserve for expected upcoming capital improvements at Camp) was valued at \$80,615. The Education Building Fund still holds \$11,468 and these funds are earmarked to aid Camp through the establishment of a Curatorial Fund that will provide ongoing funds for the care and maintenance of the Museum collections. We are in good position to aid Camp moving forward as new capital improvements have been identified (the pool renovations) and will be tackled in 2023.

Nature Camp continues to be blessed with dedicated and strong volunteer leadership on both the NCF and NCI Boards. NCF offered a slate of officers in our recent election. We said a fond farewell to Adam Rotche, who has served for 2 three year terms as the NCF At-Large member. We are excited to welcome Barak Brashear as our new At-large member and he will be working on projects such as our Fall Hike Day. And we welcome back for a second term our President, Nell Fredericksen and Service Weekend Chair, Theta Miller. The work that these folks do on behalf of the Foundation and for Nature Camp is at times herculean. Please thank them, give them hugs now that we can do that, and let them know how much they are appreciated.

As always, we must recognize the continuing and invaluable contributions of the members of the Nature Camp, Inc. board and of Philip Coulling, the Executive Director of Nature Camp and Ventry Smith, Nature Camp Caretaker. These folks go above and beyond giving so much to assure the continued viability of Nature Camp now and well into the future. It is their leadership that sustains the wonderful tradition of the Nature Camp experience.
