## The Year in Review

The Nature Camp Foundation has enjoyed a year of normality. We have been able to continue and increase our support of Nature Camp as they offer environmental hands-on learning to a cadre of enthusiastic youth and adults and of keeping our Camp family well informed of all things Camp. The valley was alive this summer with full sessions and Covid finally was not an issue. Nature Camp is looking forward to many more summers of “normality” and the Foundation is poised to provide any needed support.

And speaking of support, the Nature Camp Foundation experienced another year of strong donor support. Our Nature Camp family continually amazes us with your generosity, and we are deeply grateful for all the support you all have shown throughout the years. Nature Camp is thriving because of you. Our continued ability to support the mission of Nature Camp and provide much needed financial support in many areas is due to the unwavering support of all of you – campers, parents of campers, staff, alumni, volunteers, garden clubs, foundations, and other community organizations.

In 2023 your support exceeded the annual fund goal set by the NCF yet again! These funds allowed us to support Nature Camp in these key areas for 2023:

- Capital improvements around Camp were highlighted by the total renovation of the swimming pool which was completed in the spring of 2023.
- Construction of a whole new compost bin (after a tree fell on the old one!!)
- A second new washing machine for the Outhouse.
- New chairs for the LS and stools for the Lab.
- A new AED (automated external defibrillator)
- Repairs to the Boys Bunkhouse porch
- Significant Scholarship funds

The Nature Camp Foundation is continually working to streamline and increase efficiency of our constituent management system, eTapestry, which continues to provide a much-needed functionality to facilitate staying in touch with members of the Nature Camp community through the Afterglow and periodic emails, and to allow us to track and acknowledge donations and in-kind service. We have moved to online registration for all NCF hosted events at Nature Camp as well as graduating from paper to online waivers for all attendees. These forms allow us to make sure we have needed information such as numbers for meals (plus special dietary needs), sleeping arrangements, t-shirt sizes etc. These have been functioning quite well and we appreciate your patience as we get these into normal use.

The NCF remains in strong financial shape. The NCF ended 2023 with net assets of \$1,394,708. At year end the Legacy Account, a fund supporting the long-term operation and mission of Nature Camp, held \$732,905. Our scholarship accounts, which provide a long-term source of financial assistance to campers, were valued as follows: The Gus Deeds

Scholarship Account at \$71,696, the Stuart Craig Scholarship Account at \$36,615, the Emma Nicholas Scholarship Account at \$14,579, and the NCF Scholarship Account at \$241,163. And we ended the year with \$129,511 in operating funds. The NCF Operational Reserve Fund (holding funds in reserve for expected upcoming capital improvements at Camp) was valued at \$90,393. The Curatorial Fund (funds left over from the Education Building Fund) was valued at \$11,468 and will begin to aid Camp in the care and maintenance of the Education Building beginning in 2024.

Nature Camp continues to be blessed with dedicated and strong volunteer leadership on both the NCF and NCI Boards. We said a fond and deeply grateful farewell to three of our board members: Sarah Hulcher, who has served 2 three-year terms as the NCF Vice-President, Elizabeth Knapp, who has served for 2 three-year terms as the chair of the NCF Finance Committee, and Theta Miller who has served for 4 years as our Service Weekend Committee Chair. NCF offered a slate of officers in our recent election. Jason Farr finished his term as NCF At-Large board member and was elected to the position of Vice-President, a role for which he is extremely qualified! We are excited to welcome Adam Rotche back to the board in his new role as our Service Weekend Chair. We welcome new board members Emily Sproul as our Finance Chair, and Simon McKay as our new 2<sup>nd</sup> At-Large board member. The work that these folks do on behalf of the Foundation and for Nature Camp is at times herculean. Please thank them and let them know how much they are appreciated.

As always, we must recognize the continuing and invaluable contributions of the members of the Nature Camp, Inc. board and of Philip Coulling, the Executive Director of Nature Camp and Ventry Smith, Nature Camp Caretaker. These folks go above and beyond, giving so much to assure the continued viability of Nature Camp now and well into the future. It is their leadership that sustains the wonderful tradition of the Nature Camp experience.

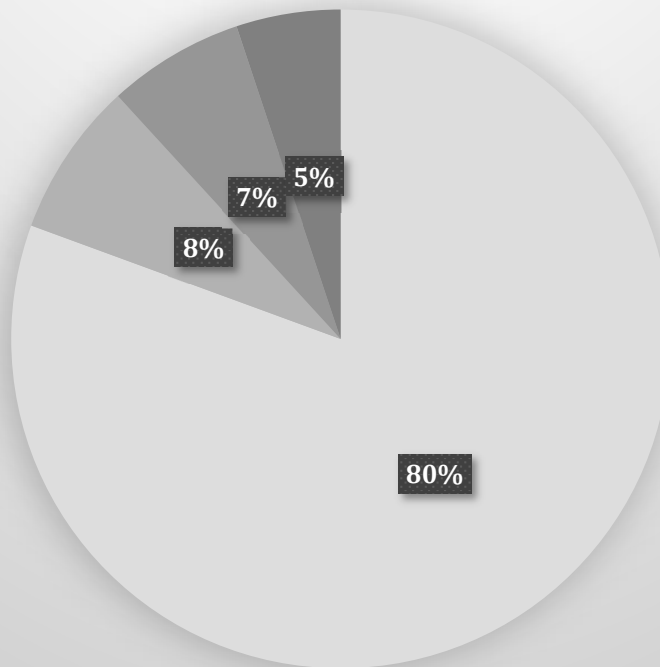
