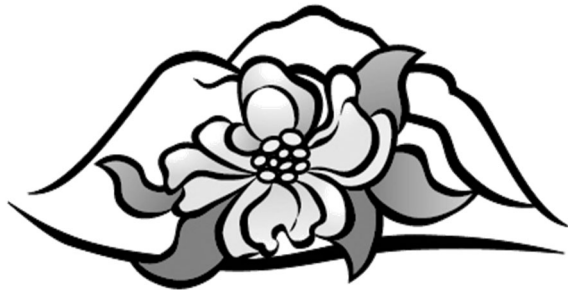

The Year in Review

The Nature Camp Foundation has enjoyed a year of great events, gatherings, and full support of Nature Camp in their mission of offering environmental hands-on learning to a cadre of enthusiastic youth and adults. We continue to keep our Camp family well informed of all the things going on with the Foundation and Nature Camp through emails, social media postings, and our newsletter, the Afterglow. The valley was alive this summer with full sessions and Nature Camp is looking forward to many more transformative summers and the Foundation is poised to provide any needed support.

And speaking of support, the Nature Camp Foundation experienced another year of strong donor support. Our Nature Camp family continually amazes us with your generosity, and we are deeply grateful for all the support you all have shown throughout the years. Nature Camp is thriving because of you. Our continued ability to support the mission of Nature Camp and provide much needed financial support in many areas is due to the unwavering support of all of you – campers, parents of campers, staff, alumni, volunteers, garden clubs, foundations, and other community organizations.

In 2024 your support exceeded the annual fund goal set by the NCF yet again! Your gifts enabled us to support Nature Camp in these key areas:

- Capital improvements around Camp were highlighted by the purchase of a new generator to keep Camp functioning during power outages and a new ware washing machine brought the kitchen back up to tip top shape.
- A new coffee brewing system in the LS (this has been a huge hit at Adult session, NCF hosted events, and with the staff during the summer).
- New chairs for the Museum.
- A new digital system for tracking camper medical records (CampDoc).
- Repairs to the Health Center roof.
- Refurbished volleyball and basketball courts, complete with a new basketball backboard.
- Significant Scholarship funds.

The Nature Camp Foundation is continually working to streamline and increase efficiency of our constituent management system, eTapestry, which continues to provide a much-needed functionality to facilitate staying in touch with members of the Nature Camp community through the Afterglow and periodic emails, and to allow us to track and acknowledge donations and in-kind service. An online registration tool for all NCF-hosted events at Nature Camp and the use of online waivers has aided us greatly as well.

The NCF remains in strong financial shape. The NCF ended 2024 with net assets of \$1,645,690. At year end the Legacy Account, a fund supporting the long-term operation and mission of Nature Camp, held \$829,488. Our scholarship accounts, which provide a long-term source of financial assistance to campers, were valued as follows: The Gus Deeds

Scholarship Account at \$76,096, the Stuart Craig Scholarship Account at \$42,617, the Emma Nicholas Scholarship Account at \$18,360, the newly established Hester Family Scholarship Account at \$20,000, and the NCF Scholarship Account at \$339,685. And we ended the year with \$144,829 in operating funds. The NCF Operational Reserve Fund (holding funds in reserve for expected upcoming capital improvements at Camp) was valued at \$100,198. The Curatorial Activity Committee Fund (funds left over from the Education Building Fund) was valued at \$11,468 and will aid Camp in the care and maintenance of the newly renovated Education Building.

Nature Camp continues to be blessed with dedicated and strong volunteer leadership on both the NCF and NCI Boards. We said a fond and deeply grateful farewell to long term board member Amy Gonzalez, who has served 1 partial and 2 three-year terms as the NCF Development Committee Chair. Amy is to be congratulated on the hard work she has done to bring NCF into the digital age through her work with eTapestry, online registrations, online waivers, and doing a bang-up job keeping you all energized in supporting our fund-raising efforts. NCF offered a slate of officers in our recent election. Emily Cruz joined the board as our new Development chair, Simon McKay as our new Secretary and Emily Montgomery as our new At-Large board member. The work that these folks do on behalf of the Foundation and for Nature Camp is at times herculean. Please thank them and let them know how much they are appreciated.

As always, we must recognize the continuing and invaluable contributions of the members of the Nature Camp, Inc. board and of Philip Coulling, the Executive Director of Nature Camp, and Ventry Smith, Nature Camp Caretaker. These folks go above and beyond, giving so much to assure the continued viability of Nature Camp now and well into the future. It is their leadership that sustains the wonderful tradition of the Nature Camp experience.

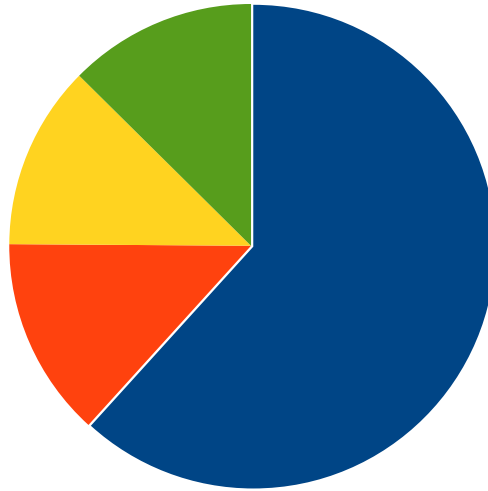
